Roller Skis:

- For the main competition (42 km) and the youth competition, participants are free to choose their preferred wheel type. The wheels must adhere to international roller ski rules (see the rules listed on the homepage)

For the categories Schoolchildren I/II, participants are free to choose their preferred wheel type (skate wheels) with the following restrictions:

- They must be serially produced (no self-made or special constructions are permitted – meaning, no non-branded wheel can be used).
- **Maximum wheel diameter = 80 mm. Minimum wheel width = 30 mm** (28 mm for SRB JR04 und Fischer RCJ)
- As per FIS rules, the axis spacing must be a minimum of 530 mm.
- Recommended roller skis: Start 71, SRB JR04 – Fischer RCJ
- Prohibited roller skis: Junior Speed Roller 80 mm (e.g. Maplus Speed 530mm or similar models)
- Ski roller assessment 45 minutes before the start at the start number/chip return station on the finish

straight (end of the pit lane) and directly before the start of the race.

- The non-compliance to any of these rules results in immediate disqualification.
